**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN ALCESTER, BROOM & SAMBOURNE - SURFACE DRESSING 2017**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing various roads as indicated in the schedule below, to vehicular traffic.

<b>BROOM</b>	Millers Bank	From the junction with Mill Lane to the end of road	27-29 April 2017	N/A Cul de sac
<b>BROOM</b>	Mill Close	From the junction with Mill Lane to the end of the road	27-29 April 2017	N/A Cul de sac
<b>BROOM</b>	Mill Lane	From the junction with High Street to the junction with Bidford Road	27-29 April 2017	High Street, Bidford Road and Vice Versa
<b>SAMBOURNE</b>	Middletown Lane	From the junction with The Green to Cain Brook	27-29 April 2017	Bromsgrove Road, Node Hill, The Slough, Jill Lane, Sambourne Lane and Vice Versa

The closures are required for carriageway surface dressing works.

The Order will commence on 27 April 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
