Bidford-on-Avon Parish Council's aim is to improve the quality of life of the people of the parish and ensure it is a desirable, safe and sustainable place to live and work.

Bidford-on-Avon Parish Council's Aims and Vision

The Parish Council is committed to improve, maintain, strengthen and support the many local community associations and groups that help to make a positive difference in Bidford-on-Avon.

The Parish Council is looking to enable local community associations and groups to benefit the local community and improve the quality of life of some or all residents. Its aim is to involve the community and make a difference, not only through its grant process, but also by exploring other ways in which they can grow and develop.

Grants are awarded by the Parish Council to community organisations, or individuals to enable them to get started or continue contributing to the local community.

Grant Process and Guidelines

The Parish Council will consider grant applications 4 times a year, at its Parish Council meetings of :

- July
- October
- January
- March

Applications received will be considered first by the Amenities Working Group, which will make its recommendation to full council. The amount of funds available per quarter will be £5,000: any funds not allocated in that quarter will be carried over for possible allocation in the following quarter.

All organisations and individuals which are awarded a grant must make a full report to the Parish Council on how the money was spent and what benefits were derived from it.

Organisations or individuals will need to fully complete the attached Grant Application.

Completed application forms must be received by the Clerk no later than:

- 10th July
- 10th October
- 10th January
- 10th March
