BURGLARY DWELLING

At approximately 11:40 hours on Monday 21st March a male offender was spotted at a house on the High Street, Welford. The offender has forced the rear patio doors of the property and stolen jewellery and silverware from within.

The offender has been described as a white male, about 6ft tall with dark, wavy, thick hair and of average build.

THREE ARRESTED

Three males were arrested last week following a number of auto crimes in the Earlswood area. Following their arrest a series of car and house searches were conducted by the Police and a number of property items were discovered relating to dwelling burglaries on The Common, Earlswood. Several victims have since identified their stolen property.

The three males have been released on bail following further Police enquiries.
