This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud.

BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

At approximately 18:00 hours on Friday 8thth April unknown offender/s have smashed the alarm box and dented the steel door of Bidford Youth Club. Further details surrounding the incident are unknown at present. Incident number 181 of 8th April refers

Sometime between Thursday 8th April and 10:00 hours on Saturday 9th April offender/s unknown have removed the window of a premises in Bidford, stealing a coat from within. Incident number 132 of 11th April refers

At approximately 21:18 hours on Monday 11th April unknown offender/s have broken into a commercial premises on Foxes Lane, Wilmcote via the rear of the premises. An untidy search has been made. It is unknown at present whether property has been stolen from within.

At approximately 00:20 hours on Friday 15th April unknown offender/s in two vehicles, one a black hatchback, has removed glass from a shop window in Welford. Offender/s have loaded property from the shop into dustbins and made off from the scene. Incident number 2 of 15th April refers

Sometime before 09:00 hours on Thursday 14th April unknown offender/s have used a screwdriver to force the door of a commercial premises on Wellington Road, Bidford. Offender/s have stolen ladders from within. Incident number 105 of 14th April refers

Sometime before 07:35 hours on Thursday 14th April unknown offender/s have used a screwdriver to force the door of a commercial premises on Wellington Road, Bidford. Once inside offender/s have made a failed attempt to kick through a wall into an adjoining premise. Offender/s have made off from the scene with a mobile phone. Between 11:00 hours and 18:00 hours on Friday 8th April unknown offender/s have interfered with the door lock of a Peugeot 406 motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on Foxes Lane, Wilmcote. No entry to the vehicle was gained. Incident number 282 of 11th April refers

Sometime before 06:30 hours on Thursday 14th April unknown offender/s have attacked the door handles of a vehicle parked secure and unattended in Welford. It is not known at present if any property has been stolen from within or if entry to the vehicle was gained.

Sometime between 16:40 hours and 17:05 hours on Friday 15th April unknown offender/s have smashed the window of a Renault Espace motor vehicle parked secure and unattended in Temple Grafton. Offender/s have stolen a laptop computer from within.

VIOLENT CRIME

At approximately 22:13 hours on Friday 8th April a male youth has reported the theft of his mobile phone by an offender at Bidford Skate ramp. The offender has lifted up his jumper to reveal a knife pouch. One offender has been arrested in connection. Incident number 540 of 8th April refers

At approximately 14:00 hours on Friday 8th April a male youth has reported being assaulted, while playing tennis on the High Street, Bidford. Incident number 482 of 8th April refers

At approximately 22:13 hours on Saturday 9th April a male youth has reported being assaulted on the High Street, Bidford. One offender has been arrested in connection with this incident.

SOMETHING TO SHOUT ABOUT

At approximately 20:13 hours on Tuesday 5th April a call was received by Police stating that a male youth had gone into Booze Busters on the High Street, Studley, grabbed a 24 pack of Carlesburg larger and ran off in the direction of the park.

Moments after this incident occurred CCTV operatives spotted two males, fitting the description of the offenders, drinking from cans of bear near to Studley medical centre. Police officers were despatched to the scene and the offender was arrested. He has now been released on bail pending further Police enquiries.

At approximately 22:04 hours on Tuesday 5th April a call was received by Police stating that youths had been seen entering the grounds of Studley High School and were now vandalising cars and property.

Police officers were dispatched to the area and following a brief foot chase one offender was arrested for criminal damage. The offender has admitted his part in the damage caused at the school and has now been bailed until 10:00 hours on Tuesday 19th April.

Four persons were also arrested last week following a string of burglary dwelling offences in the Tanworth in Arden area. Police enquiries into the incident are continuing.
