BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Sometime before 17:47 hours on Monday 8th August unknown offender/s have entered a utility room at the side of a premises in Abbots Salford by unknown means. Offender/s have stolen a number of household items from within.

SOMETHING TO SHOUT ABOUT

OFFENDERS ARRESTED

At 22:00 hours on Tuesday 9th August two offenders have been arrested in connection with shoplifting offences from the Tesco Express and Co-op Store in Studley. Enquiries are continuing.

Two offender/s have been arrested following a number of burglary other offences in Bearley. The pair have been bailed while further enquiries continue.

NATIONAL 'IN CASE OF EMERGENCY' CAMPAIGN

A Cambridge based paramedic has launched a national campaign with Vodaphone to encourage people to store emergency contact details in their mobile phones.

Bob Brotchie, a clinical team leader for East Anglian Ambulance NHS Trust, devised the plan last year after struggling to get contact details from shocked or injured patients.

The Idea is that you store the word "I C E" (in case of emergency) into your mobile phone address book and against it enter the number of the person you would want contacted "in case of emergency".

In an emergency situation Police, Ambulance, other first responders and hospital staff will then be able to quickly find out who your next of kin are and be able to contact them sooner rather than later.

The idea follows research carried out by Vodaphone that shows more than 75% of people carry no details of who they would like contacted in an emergency.

"Almost everyone carries a mobile phone now and with ICE we'd know immediately who to contact and what number to ring" Said Bob Brotchie. "As many people say they carry mobile phones in case of an emergency, it seems natural that this information should be kept there."
