BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Sometime before 10:00 hours on Saturday 10th September unknown offender/s have entered a commercial premises on Waterloo Road, Bidford by unknown means. Offender/s have stolen kitchen appliances, computers and phones from within. Incident number 245 of 10th September refers

Sometime between Saturday 10th September and Monday 12th September unknown offender/s have gained entry to a garden shed in Salford Priors, by cutting the bolt. Offender/s have stolen a Honda lawnmower from within. Incident number 440 of 12th September refers



AUTOCRIME

Between 20:00 hours on Tuesday 6th September and 08:30 hours on Wednesday 7th September unknown offender/s have stolen four road wheels from a BMW motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on the High Street, Bidford by unknown means. Incident number 137 of 7th September refers

At approximately 14:54 hours on Thursday 8th September two males in a grey Vauxhall Corsa have stolen a blue in colour Vauxhall Brava pick-up parked secure and unattended on Irons Cross, Salford Priors by unknown means. Incident number 279 of 8th September refers

Between 22:00 hours on Thursday 8th September and 09:00 hours on Friday 9th September unknown offender/s have smashed the window of a Saab motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on St. Laurence Way, Bidford. VIOLENT CRIME

At approximately 16:00 hours on Thursday 14th September an unknown offender has approached an 8 year old boy whilst out playing in the play area, Lower Quinton. The male offender has said to the boy “come on your mum said to get in, your mum said to take you home”
