BURGLARY DWELLING

Sometime before 11:00 hours on Friday 6th January unknown offender/s have removed the UPVC trim from the rear patio doors of a premises on St Laurence Way, Bidford and attempted to force entry. No entry to the premises has been gained and offender/s have made off in an unknown direction.

Incident number 191 of 6th January refers

At approximately 20:57 hours on Monday 9th January unknown offender/s have approached the rear of a premises on the Barton Road, Welford and have forced the rear patio doors with a crowbar or similar. Offender/s appear to have gone through to the hallway and made a tidy search of cabinet drawers. It appears that the alarm to the premises has then sounded and the offender/s have made off in an unknown direction. It is not known at present whether any property has been stolen.

Incident number 559 of 9th January refers

Sometime Between 08:00 hours and 20:12 hours on Wednesday 11th January unknown offender/s have forced the lock to the front door of a premises on the Stratford Road, Bidford on Avon. Once inside offender/s have pulled the doors off of a cabinet in a downstairs room. It is not known at present if any property has been stolen.

Incident number 541 of 11th January refers

Sometime before Sunday 15th January unknown offender/s have attempted to gain entry to a premises on Friday Close, Bidford, without success. The IP in this case has reported screwdriver marks on the window sills and french doors of the property.

Between 16:00 hours and 20:45 hours on Saturday 7th January unknown offender/s have stolen both registration plates from a grey Rover 216 motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on the Leys, Bidford.

OTHER INCIDENTS OF INTEREST / HATE CRIME / CRIMINAL DAMAGE

At approximately 19:35 hours on Friday 6th January two male youths have hailed a bus in the village of Lower Quinton.

The bus driver has declined to let the two youths on to the bus and has driven off. The two youths have then thrown bricks at the rear window of the bus causing it to damage. Incident number 189 of 6th January refers

At approximately 21:05 hours on Saturday 7th January several motorists driving past Waterloo Road, Bidford have had their vehicles damaged by what are possibly airgun pellets.

At approximately 18:55 hours on Monday 9th January unknown offender/s have caused damage to two fencing panels outside a premises in Lower Quinton. A witness has seen three youths running away from the scene just before the damage was discovered. Incident number 455 of 9th January refers

Sometime before 21:15 hours on Thursday 12th January unknown youths have been seen to throw a number of stones at a greenhouse in the rear garden of a premises on Quinneys lane, Bidford. Offender/s have made off from the scene.
