### **BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING**

At approximately 01:00 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February unknown offender/s have removed a window from a school premises in Bidford by unknown means. Once inside offender/s have stolen a computer and projector from within.

Before 07:50 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February unknown offender/s have gained entry to Temple Grafton Primary School via a storeroom window. ### **AUTOCRIME**
