BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

During overnight hours on Tuesday 21st February unknown offender/s have forced the rear doors of a retail premises on the High Street, Bidford by unknown means. Once inside offender/s have stolen a number of cigarettes from within before making good their escape in an unknown direction. No other details surrounding the incident are present at this time. AUTOCRIME
