BURGLARY DWELLING

Between 07:25 hours and 16:05 hours on Monday 6th March unknown offender/s have gained entry to a premises on St. Swithins Drive, Lower Quinton by unknown means. Once inside offender/s have stolen a number of electrical items before making good their escape.

Between 13:00 hours and 17:20 hours on Sunday 19th March unknown offender/s have jumped the back fence to the garden of a premises on Thackeray Close, Lower Quinton. Offender/s have then smashed the bottom Pane of glass in the kitchen door in an attempt to gain entry. Offender/s have however not gained entry to the premises as the families dogs were present.

BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 13:00 hours on Saturday 18th March and 08:10 hours on Monday 20th March unknown offender/s have forced the padlock of an outbuilding to a premises on the Birmingham Road, Pathlow. Once inside offender/s have stolen £400.00 worth of heating oil from within.

AUTOCRIME

Between 01:00 hours and 06:00 hours on Tuesday 7th March 2006 unknown offender/s have entered a van parked secure and unattended on Glebe Close, Bidford by punching the side door lock. Once inside offender/s have stolen approximately 83 boxes of computer equipment valued at around £15,000 before making good their escape.

At approximately 13:17 hours on Wednesday 8th March a group of unknown youths have throw a number of stones at a vehicle driving along the B4632 through Bidford causing damage to the windscreen of the vehicle.

Between 14:30 hours on Saturday 4th March and 09:30 hours on Thursday 9th March unknown offender/s have entered a secured field off Cleeve Road, Bidford via a public footpath. Once inside offender/s have proceeded to remove two rear wheels and a spare wheel from a 7½ ton lorry by use of a jack. Offender/s have then made good their escape in an unknown direction.

Incident number 390 of 10th March refers

At approximately 15:22 hours on Sunday 19th March unknown offender/s have stolen a blue Land Rover Discovery motor vehicle parked unattended and possibly insecure on Grafton Lane, Bidford.

Incident number 306 of the 19th March refers

At approximately 04:00 hours on Thursday 16th March unknown offender/s have smashed the heated rear windscreen of a Vauxhall Vectra motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on Swanfold, Wilmcote, which has activated the vehicle alarm. Offender/s have gained entry to the boot area and stolen a laptop computer from within before making good their escape in an unknown direction.

Between 14:00 hours on Friday 10th March and 10:00 hours on Saturday 11th March unknown offender/s have approached a blue Rover 216 motor vehicle parked secure and unattended on The Leys, Bidford and have proceeded to use bodily pressure to attack both wing mirrors.
