This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week ending 5th May 2007

BURGLARY DWELLING

Between 1700 hours 2nd May and 0600 hours 3rd May 06 unknown offender/s have gained entry to a new build dwelling in Victoria Road, Bidford by using a heat instrument on the double glazed plastic windows. Once heated they have removed the glass from the frame and climbed through. Offender/s have then stolen £400 worth of paint from within.

BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Overnight between 24th and 25th April 06 unknown offender/s have forced off padlocks to 3 metal storage sheds in School Road, Salford Priors. Nothing stolen.

Between 0130 hours and 0915 hours on 25th April 06 a wooden shed on Evesham Road, Salford Priors was entered and an electric drill, chapsaw, de walt cordless drill and nail gun stolen.

Overnight between 30th April and 1st May 06 unknown offender/s have gained entry to the rear of a premises in Pitchill, Evesham and stolen approximately 50 hanging baskets

AUTOCRIME

Between 1400 hours 14th April 06 and 1700 hours 17th April 06 unknown offender/s have approached a vehicle parked on a driveway in Thackeray Close, Lower Quinton and slashed a 'z' shape into the front off side tyre.

Incident 582 of 21st April 06 refers.

Between 2200 hours 26th April and 0700 hours 27th April 06 unknown offender/s have approached a parked secure unattended VW Golf Motor Vehicle in The Meadows, Bidford. The offender/s have then caused damage to the door lock gaining access to the vehicle allowing them to steal a satellite navigation system, a laptop computer and a digital camera from within.

Between 2230 hours 26th April 06 and 0810 hours 27th April 06 unknown offender/s have approached a VW Passatt vehicle parked secure and unattended in St Laurence Way, Bidford. The offender/s have then attacked the door lock and gained access to the inside of the vehicle stealing CD's and Sunglasses from within the glovebox. They have also stolen a mobile phone and golf clubs from within the boot.

Between 1400 hours and 1820 hours 27th April 06 unknown offender/s have approached a Honda Legend motor vehicle parked insecure and unattended at a business premises on Bidford industrial estate, Bidford. The offender/s have then opened the insecure door and stolen a wallet from inside a jacket.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 1200 hours 23rd April and 1915 hours on 25th April 06 unknown offender/s have smashed 8 panes of glass in a Georgian window to a premise on School Road, Salford Priors.

Between 2300 hours 30th April 06 and 0750 hours 1st May 06 unknown offender/s have used a silver spray paint to paint along the side of a motor vehicle parked in Goose Lane, Lower Quinton.

Overnight between 30th April 06 and 1st May 06 unknown offender/s have sprayed paint over the front door to a dwelling on Poland Avenue, Lower Quinton.

Between 1300 hours 30th April and 0800 hours 2nd May 06 unknown offender/s have thrown an unknown object at a window causing it to break on Main Road, Lower Quinton.
