BURGLARY DWELLING



BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 2230 hours 8th June 06 and 0545 hours 9th June 06 unknown offender/s have attempted to break in to a business premises on Salford Road, Bidford. They have smashed the key box to the shutters and have tried to car jack the rear doors open. No entry gained, nothing stolen.
Incident number 64 of 9th June 06 refers.



AUTOCRIME

Overnight between 6th and 7 June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a 16-seater mini coach parked secure and unattended in Laurence Way, Bidford. They have then forced an unknown item through the door skin of the front offside door. Once inside they have then stolen the Tom Tom satellite navigation system and credit cards.

Between 1900 hours 7th June 06 and 0800 hours 8th June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a 740 BMW parked secure and unattended in Park Lane, Great Alne. They have then gained entry by unknown means through the front near side door. Once inside they have stolen a mobile phone from inside the central armrest.

Between 0830 hours and 0950 hours on 8th June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a Peugeot Van parked in Headlands Road, Welford on Avon. The front off side window was left down approximately 1", offender/s have popped the lock and stolen a wallet and cigarettes from the drivers seat and dash.

Between 2200 hours 7th June 06 and 0700 hours 8th June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a Mitsubishi Show Gun parked secure and unattended in Howard Close, Bidford. They have forced the drivers door lock to gain access and once inside they have carried out an untidy search of the contents. They have stolen a Road Angela safety device and keys for other vehicles.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 1830 hours and 2215 hours of 31st May 06 unknown offender/s have approached the communal area of a block of flats in Wadleys Close, Bidford and smashed the cupboard containing bins. The offender/s have also turned the electricity off to one of the flats.

Between 1600 hours and 1900 hours unknown offender/s have approached a Ford Fiesta parked secure and unattended in Swans Close, Wilmcote and smashed the windscreen. Nothing stolen.
