## BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING



Between 1600 hours 10<sup>th</sup> June 06 and 1200 hours 11<sup>th</sup> June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a parked, secure and unattended BMW Mini parked in The Nashes, Clifford Chambers. They have used a sharp instrument to drag along the side of the vehicle causing deep scratches around the fuel cap approximately 18" long. Incident number 338 of 11<sup>th</sup> June 06 refers.
