

# **BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL**

## **In the County of Warwickshire**



This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week ending 11<sup>th</sup> August 2006

### **BURGLARY DWELLING**

Between 1330 hours and 1800 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have approached a property in Clifford Chambers. Access was then gained through an open patio door. Once inside they have stolen two sets of house keys and a Toshiba Satellite laptop computer which can only be used in the USA.

Incident number 357 of 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 refers.

Between 2300 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> July 06 and 0700 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a property in Duck Lane, Welford on Avon. They have then used body pressure to force the back door, reached in and removed the key to unlock the door. The upper bolt on the door prevented offender/s from gaining entry.

Incident number 95 of 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 refers.



### **BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING**

Sometime since 27<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have approached the garage of a property in Blenheim Close, Bidford on Avon and stolen a tent from within.

Incident number 238 of 7<sup>th</sup> August 06 refers.

At approximately 0700 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 a male was seen to approach premises in Campden Road, Clifford Chambers. He then used a house brick to smash a window to the rear of the property in an attempt to gain entry. Offender was arrested at the scene and questioned by Police.

Incident number 217 of 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 refers.

Between 2345 hours on 6<sup>th</sup> August 06 and 1745 hours on 7<sup>th</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached premises in High Street, Bidford on Avon. They have then gained access into the cellar by kicking the cellar doors. Once inside they have stolen a quantity of coke and wine.

Incident number 504 of 7<sup>th</sup> August 06 refers.

During the evening of 6<sup>th</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached premises in Campden Road, Clifford Chambers. They then forced a window in order to gain entry. Nothing believed stolen.

Incident number 303 of 6<sup>th</sup> August 06 refers.

Overnight between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached business units in Honeybourne Road, Bidford on Avon and smashed off several padlocks.

## **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

Between 0300 hours and 0930 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have approached a property in Campden Road, Clifford Chambers and broken down a wooden perimeter fence. They have also left open the two gates to the rear of the property. No further damage and no attempt at entry was made.

## **THEFT**

Between 0900 hours and 1310 hours on 27<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have entered a surgery in High Street, Bidford on Avon. Once inside they have reached into a cupboard and stolen a pink leather purse from a bag within. The purse contained cash and a bank debit card which was subsequently used to withdraw several sums of cash.

Incident number 319 of 27<sup>th</sup> July 06 refers.

At approximately 1730 hours on 28<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have approached a restaurant in High Street, Bidford on Avon and stolen a silver Nokia 8800 mobile phone from under the bar.

Incident number 594 of 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 refers.

Between 2200 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> July 06 and 0400 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> July 06 unknown offender/s have approached an orange Vauxhall Combo van in Millers Close, Welford on Avon. They have then stolen a bag and driving licence. Method of entry not known. Vehicle may have been left insecure.

Incident number 111 of 31<sup>st</sup> July 06 refers.

Between 0745 hours and 1545 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a tent on a campsite in Welford Road, Barton, Bidford on Avon. They have cut the fly sheet to gain entry and then stolen two mobile phones.

Incident number 379 of 2<sup>nd</sup> August 06 refers.

Between 1900 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> July 06 and 0620 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a blue Mazda parked on the driveway of a property in School Avenue, Salford Priors. They have then smashed the front near side window and searched the glovebox. Offender/s may have been looking for the satellite navigation system but this had been removed.

Incident number 75 of 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 refers.

Between 2300 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> July 06 and 0750 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a silver Mercedes in Old School Mead, Bidford. They have then put a hole in the drivers door window in order to reach through and steal the Tom Tom satellite navigation system.

Incident number 89 of 1<sup>st</sup> August 06 refers.



## **BE AWARE**

**An operation has started called Operation Longbridge which is targeting vehicle crime, in particular thefts of trailers and Land Rovers and will run for the next four weeks. There will be high visibility patrols in an attempt to prevent and detect these offences.**

**All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment.
