BURGLARY DWELLING



BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

At approximately 0145 hours on 28th August 06 unknown offender/s approached a brick outhouse attached to a detached garage in Evesham Road, Salford Priors. They have then forced the hasp and staple securing the wooden door. Once inside they have stolen a quantity of fishing equipment, Matika angle grinder, cordless drills and 100 volt transformer.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 1900 hours on 3rd September 06 and 1630 hours on 4th September 06 unknown offender/s have damaged five gates at a Social Centre in Salford Road, Bidford on Avon. Incident number 608 of 4th September 06 refers.



THEFT

At some time between 21st August 06 and 26th August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a farm in Tothall Lane, Salford Priors and stolen four road wheels and tyres and a locking bar belonging to an Ifor Williams trailer. They have also taken a blue petrol generator.

Incident number 476 of 26th August 06 refers.

Between 1100 hours on 27th August 06 and 1000 hours on 28th August 06 unknown offender/s have approached a white Peugeot parked in Icknield Street, Bidford on Avon and stolen a Goodmans radio and car manual.

Incident number 165 of 28th August 06 refers.

At approximately 1000 hours on 31st August 06 unknown offender/s approached a lady shopping at a car boot sale in Honeybourne Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then bumped into her and stolen her purse from her handbag.

Incident number 239 of 31st August 06 refers.

At around 0430 hours on 1st September 06 unknown offender/s approached a Volvo motor vehicle parked in Drayton Close, Bidford on Avon. They have then smashed the rear windscreen and stolen a brown leather briefcase and De Walt automatic leveller.

Incident number 58 of 1st September 06 refers.

Between 1200 hours on 2nd September 06 and 1000 hours on 6th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a lean-to in the rear garden of a property in Clifford Chambers. They have then stolen a red Honda generator.

Incident number 210 of 6th September 06 refers.

At approximately 2140 hours on 2nd September 06 five youths approached a white Sprinter van parked in Grafton Lane, Bidford on Avon. They have then broken into the vehicle and stolen bags of dog food. Offenders believed to have made off in a silver "T" reg Rover.

Incident number 688 of 2nd September 06 refers.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an ‘incident number’ – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are ‘managed’ and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

CRIMESTOPPERS

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
