This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week ending 22nd September 2006

BURGLARY DWELLING

Between 1630 hours on 10th September 06 and 0915 hours on 11th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a newly completed property in Waterloo Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then broken glass in the front door to gain entry. Once inside they have stolen a quantity of paint.

Incident number 127 of 11th September 06 refers.



BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 1700 hours on 8th September 06 and 0800 hours on 9th September 06 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Campden Road, Lower Quinton, Stratford on Avon. They have then gained entry by lifting the gate off its hinges. Once inside they have stolen a quantity of Cotswold wall effect blocks and some clay pots.

Incident number 359 of 9th September 06 refers.

Some time prior to 8th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a barn in the grounds of a property on Birmingham Road, Pathlow, Stratford on Avon. They have then entered the barn via an unlocked door and stolen two milk churns and some wood. Incident number 266 of 8th September 06 refers.

Overnight between 12th September and 13th September 06 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Campden Road, Lower Quinton. They have then lifted off the gates and stolen a quantity of tools, garden furniture and the computer. Incident number 123 of 13th September 06 refers.

Between 1800 hours on 13th September 06 and 0900 hours on 15th September 06 unknown offender/s approached an insecure garage at a property in Wyre Lane, Long Marston. They have then stolen a new green Hayter lawn mower from within. Incident number 236 of 19th September 06 refers.

Between 1930 hours on 13th September 06 and 0900 hours on 14th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a property in Wyre Lane, Long Marston. They have gained entry by using a flat instrument to force open two wooden doors and force the Yale lock fitting off. Once inside they have stolen a Stihl petrol chain saw. Incident number 153 of 14th September 06 refers.

Since the evening of 15th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a farm in Irons Cross, Salford Priors. They then gained entry to a barn and stole 19 bales of hay. Incident number 234 of 18th September 06 refers.



AUTOCRIME



CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Overnight between 9th September and 10th September 06 unknown offender/s have approached a silver Vauxhall Zafira parked in Irons Cross, Salford Priors and pierced both outside tyres. Also rear off side tyre of silver Volvo parked in same location. Incident number 279 of 10th September 06 refers.

Some time prior to 10th September 06 unknown offender/s approached two portacabins on the site of a school in Welford on Avon. They then caused damage to a safety window.

Incident number 145 of 12th September 06 refers.

At approximately 2100 hours on 12th September 06 unknown offender/s have approached a vehicle parked in Thackeray Close, Lower Quinton and smashed two off side windows. Incident number 610 of 12th September 06 refers.



THEFT

Between 0800 hours and 0815 hours on 8th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a school in Bidford on Avon and stole 17 cartons of milk from the school gates.

Incident number 151 of 8th September 06 refers.

At approximately 0100 hours on 10th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a business premises at Atherstone Airfield, Atherstone on Stour. They have either climbed or cut through perimeter fence to gain entry and then stolen a supply of diesel.

Incident number 337 of 11th September 06 refers.

Between 2330 hours on 13th September 06 and 0745 hours on 14th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a motor vehicle parked at Swanfold, Wilmcote. They have then gained entry by forcing an object into the front off side door lock, tripping the electrics and causing the windows to drop. They have then jacked up the vehicle and stolen four alloy wheels.

Incident number 97 of 14th September 06 refers.

Between 1200 hours and 1330 hours on 15th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a white Vauxhall van parked insecure in Waterloo Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then stolen a toolbox from the rear of the van whilst the owner was working nearby.

Incident number 295 of 15th September 06 refers.

Between 2130 hours on 19th September 06 and 0730 hours on 20th September 06 unknown offender/s approached a motor vehicle parked in Dighton Close, Clifford Chambers. They then gained entry by punching the front off side door lock. Once inside they have stolen a Toshiba satellite pro laptop, built in satellite navigation system and car stereo.

Incident number 78 of 20th September 06 refers.



BE AWARE

If you have any information or have witnessed the above incidents, please can you contact Alcester Police on 01789 762207. Thank you. Please note Alcester Police station is temporarily based at the former Alcester Infant School, Moorfield Road, Alcester (towards Somerfield).

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an 'incident number' – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.



CRIMESTOPPERS

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
