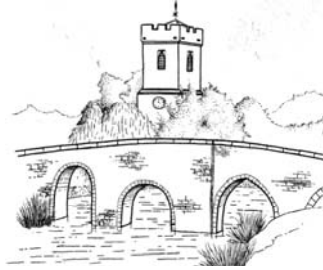


BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL

This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week ending Friday 31st August 2007

BURGLARY DWELLING

At 0015 hours on 21st August 07 offender/s have approached a property on Swanfold, Wilmcote and attempted to gain entry through an open bedroom window. Offender/s ran off when the occupant got out of bed to investigate.

BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Prior to 26th August 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Campden Road, Clifford Chambers. They have then forced a window in order to gain entry.

AUTOCRIME

Between 2115 hours on 19th August and 0700 hours on 20th August 07 unknown offender/s have approached a Golf Club in Bidford and stolen a Rover 75 motor vehicle from the location.

Between 0730 hours and 1900 hours on 20th August 07 unknown offender/s approached the rear of a property on Rumer Close, Long Marston. They have then removed a silver Talbot Samba motor vehicle.

Between 2220 hours and 2320 hours on 20th August 07 unknown offender/s have stolen a blue and grey Daihatsu Fourtrak parked in yard of airfield buildings, Campden Road, Lower Quinton.

Incident number 657 of 20th August 07 refers.

Between 2100 hours on 22nd August 07 and 1100 hours on 23rd August 07 unknown offender/s have stolen a motor vehicle parked in Upper Quinton.

Between 1800 hours on 28th August and 1245 hours on 30th August 07 unknown offender/s have stolen a green Ford Transit from a business unit on Campden Road, Clifford Chambers.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 2000 hours on 29th August and 0830 hours on 30th August unknown offender/s approached a Honda Civic parked in Abbots Salford, Evesham. They have then walked over the roof and bonnet, causing damage to the bodywork.

THEFT

Between 1600 hours on 13th August and 0900 hours on 20th August 07 unknown offender/s have removed an Abbey caravan from a farm at Weston on Avon, Stratford.

Incident number 210 of 20th August 07 refers.

Between 1950 hours and 2145 hours on 21st August 07 unknown offender/s approached a silver VW Bora parked at a hotel in Abbots Salford. They gained entry by attacking the driver's lock and have then stolen a laptop computer and CDs from within.

Incident number 572 of 21st August 07 refers.

Between 2000 hours on 21st August and 1000 hours on 22nd August 07 unknown offender/s approached a silver VW Golf parked at a hotel in Abbots Salford. They gained entry by punching the driver's door and have then carried out an untidy search of the interior.

Incident number 144 of 22nd August 07 refers.

Between 2030 hours on 22nd August and 0600 hours on 23rd August 07 unknown offender/s approached a silver Mercedes Benz parked at The Brickall, Long Marston. They have then smashed the rear windscreen and removed a laptop computer from the boot.

Incident number 45 of 23rd August 07 refers.

At approximately 1525 hours on 28th August 07 a male was seen to drive away from business premises on Binton Road, Welford on Avon. It was then noticed that a Honda whacker plate had been stolen. Male described as white, aged around 25 years with dark hair and wearing a blue and white striped top. Suspect was driving a white van. Incident number 303 of 28th August 07 refers.

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – “behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator”.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an ‘incident number’ – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are ‘managed’ and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
