## BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL In the County of Warwickshire



This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. #### **BURGLARY DWELLING**

Prior to 24<sup>th</sup> October 07 three youths gained entry to an unoccupied property on Westholme Road, Bidford on Avon. They were subsequently detained in connection with possession of illegal substances. Incident 532 of 24<sup>th</sup> October 07 refers.



#### BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 2100 hours on 8<sup>th</sup> October and 0900 hours on 9<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached premises in Irons Cross, Salford Priors and removed a quantity of hav.

Overnight between 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Duck Lane, Welford. They have then broken the padlocks off the doors to the outbuildgs and removed a portable welder, hedge cutter and set of three Stillson adjustable wrenches.

## CRIMINAL DAMAGE

#### THEFT

Between 0800 hours on 18<sup>th</sup> October and 0800 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s have stolen chevron boards from the traffic islands at Salford Priors and Oversley Mill.

Between 2030 hours on 18<sup>th</sup> October and 0330 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached a VW Tourer parked on Millfield Close, Lower Quinton. They have then smashed the side window and removed a Tom Tom Sat Nav and cradle from the windscreen, together with items from the boot. Incident 226 of 22<sup>nd</sup> October 07 refers.

Between 0145 hours and 0700 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached a motor vehicle parked on Millfield Close, Lower Quinton. They then smashed the rear quarterlight and removed a Tom Tom Sat Nav from the glovebox. Incident 98 of 19<sup>th</sup> October 07 refers.

Between 1800 hours on 23<sup>rd</sup> October and 0930 hours on 24<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises in Weston on Avon and removed 600 litres of heating oil from a tank and 1250 litres of tractor diesel. Waste copper and lead has also been removed.

Between 21<sup>st</sup> October and 26<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached a caravan park in Abbots Salford, Evesham and removed a 5' water feature statue from a garden. Incident 147 of 26<sup>th</sup> October 07 refers.

Between 1745 hours on 25<sup>th</sup> October and 0840 hours on 26<sup>th</sup> October 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Waterloo Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then gained entry to a compound and removed approximately 50 pallets. Incident 137 of 26<sup>th</sup> October 07 refers.

Between 1600 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> October and 0700 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> November 07 unknown offender/s approached premises on Welford Road, Barton. They then gained entry by damaging the lock and removed 300 litres of diesel from a main holding tank. Incident 118 of 1<sup>st</sup> November 07 refers.

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – "behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harrassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator".

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harrassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an 'incident number' – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.
