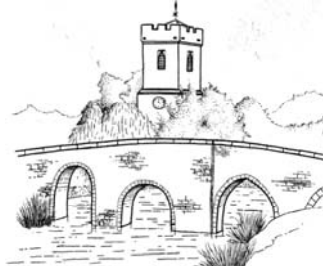


BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL

This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week ending Friday 16th November 2007

BURGLARY DWELLING



BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 1900 hours on 9th November and 0830 hours on 10th November 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Campden Road, Lower Quinton. They then smashed windows to gain access and removed keys which they used to steal a VW Golf. The vehicle was later found abandoned nearby.

Between 1900 hours on 13th November and 0500 hours on 14th November 07 unknown offender/s approached premises in Admington. They then cut the chain securing front gate and made a search of outbuildings.

AUTOCRIME

Prior to 0610 hours on 5th November 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises in Clifford Chambers. They have then stolen a mini digger and removed fuel from various vehicles.

Between 2145 hours on 13th November and 0710 hours on 14th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle left in car park near to Priors Grange, Salford Priors. They have then removed the vehicle using unknown means.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 2200 hours on 8th November and 0830 hours on 9th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle parked on Goose Lane, Lower Quinton and smashed the rear rail light.
Incident 299 of 9th November 07 refers.

Between 2000 hours on 14th November and 0915 hours on 15th November unknown offender/s approached a vehicle parked on Millfield Close, Lower Quinton and punctured all four tyres.

THEFT

Overnight between 4th and 5th November 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Waterloo Road, Bidford. They have then used an angle grinder to cut the metal security bar and removed two trailers and a quantity of axle frames.

Between 1000 hours on 5th November and 0630 hours on 6th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a property on School Road, Salford Priors and removed a 6.5kw electric generator from the car port.
Incident 42 of 6th November 07 refers.

Between June 07 and 6th November 07 unknown offender/s have stolen a quantity of copper cable from a British Telecom box on High Street, Bidford on Avon.
Incident 208 of 6th November 07 refers.

Between 0800 hours on 7th November and 1430 hours on 10th November 07 unknown offender/s have entered a cemetery and removed an ornament from a grave.
Incident 320 of 12th November 07 refers.

Between 1000 hours and 1200 hours on 7th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle parked at rear of fire station in Bidford. They have then smashed the quarter light window and stolen three holdalls from front passenger footwell.
Incident 195 of 7th November 07 refers.

Between 2145 hours on 7th November and 1300 hours on 8th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle parked on Victoria Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then forced the rear door and removed various Machita power tools.

Incident 467 of 8th November 07 refers.

Between 1000 hours and 1500 hours on 8th November 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Waterloo Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then removed a pallet full of agricultural spares.

Incident 361 of 9th November 07 refers.

Between 1800 hours on 14th November and 0630 hours on 15th November 07 unknown offender/s approached a Vauxhall Vectra parked at a hotel in Abbots Salford. They have then smashed the window and removed a case containing Dell laptop computer from behind the driver's seat.

Incident 42 of 15th November 07 refers.

Between 1930 hours on 14th November and 0730 hours on 15th November 07 unknown offender/s approached business premises on Binton Road, Welford on Avon and removed the registration plates to three vehicles.

Incident 125 of 15th November 07 refers.

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – “behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harrassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator”.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harrassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a

better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an 'incident number' – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

CRIMESTOPPERS

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
