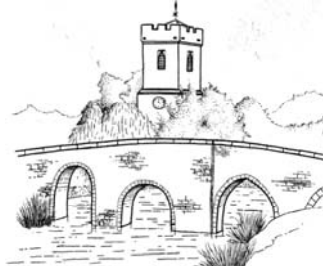


BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL

In the County of Warwickshire



This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud.
Wednesday 4th June 2008



BURGLARY DWELLING

Prior to 1540 hours on 23rd May 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on School Avenue, Salford Priors. They then used a key in an attempt to gain entry but broke the key off in the lock in the process.
Incident 346 of 23rd May 08 refers.



BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING

Between 1200 hours and 1300 hours on 21st May 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on Tothall Lane, Salford Priors. They have then forced the lock to an office situated above the garage.
Incident 246 of 21st May 08 refers.

Between 2030 hours on 22nd May and 0820 hours on 23rd May 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on Ford Lane, Langley and caused damage to the lock of a garage door.
Incident 118 of 23rd May 08 refers.

Between 0815 hours and 1615 hours on 27th May 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on Stratford Road, Bidford-on-Avon. They then gained entry to a detached garage and removed a Countax ride-on lawn mower and power tools.
Incident 359 of 27th May 08 refers.

Between 1800 hours on 2nd June and 0800 hours on 3rd June 08 unknown offender/s approached a new house on Aston Cantlow Road, Wilmcote. They then gained entry and removed power tools.

Incident 107 of 3rd June 08 refers.

Between 2100 hours on 2nd June and 0900 hours on 3rd June 08 unknown offender/s approached an allotment shed on Salford Road, Bidford-on-Avon. They then gained entry and removed a generator and power tools.

Incident 147 of 3rd June 08 refers.



CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Between 2000 hours on 20th May and 1900 hours on 21st May 08 offender/s approached a club on Salford Road, Bidford-on-Avon and smashed a window.

Incident 480 of 21st May 08 refers.

Between 1530 hours on 28th May and 1330 hours on 29th May 08 unknown offender/s approached premises in Milcote and cut a hole in the chain link.

Incident 294 of 29th May 08 refers.

At about 0130 hours on 30th May 08 unknown offender/s have approached a property on Wharrad Close, Bidford-on-Avon and broken a window.

Incident 326 of 30th May 08 refers.

Between 2240 hours on 1st June and 0930 hours on 2nd June 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Goose Lane, Lower Quinton and damaged the rear wiper blade.

Incident 228 of 2nd June 08 refers.



THEFT

Between 0800 hours on 29th May and 1420 hours on 3rd June 08 unknown offender/s approached premises in Long Marston and removed the catalytic converters from four vehicles.

Incident 311 of 3rd June 08 refers.

Prior to 1255 hours on 3rd June 08 unknown offender/s approached a motor vehicle on Barton Road, Welford-on-Avon. They then gained entry and removed a necklace.

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – “behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator”.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station

numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an 'incident number' – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

CRIMESTOPPERS

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
