CRIME IN YOUR AREA

This section looks at the crimes of public interest that have occurred on the Alcester South Safer Neighbourhood Team policing beat, crimes such as burglary, theft, auto crime and criminal damage:



BURGLARY.

- ❖ Break ins/Burglaries down slightly this month, but farms continuing to be the main target. Inc's 78/070410 and 68/090410 refer to the same farm in Binton being visited and numerous power tools being taken on both occasions.
- ❖ A large quantity of tyre was taken from a unit on Waterloo Industrial Est., Bidford, overnight of 18th April. Inc 40/190410.
- ❖ On the same night another unit was broken into on the same Industrial Est., but on this occasion nothing was taken.



AUTOCRIME.

- ❖ Only 1 incident of vehicle taking this month. Unknown offenders took 2 vehicles from an address in Binton on the night of 22nd April. Inc 41/230410. One vehicle was found shortly afterwards in Aston Cantlow.
- ❖ People are still forgetting to remove items when leaving vehicles! Inc 45/220410 refers to a laptop taken from an Audi after offenders smashed the rear windows to gain access.

- ❖ A BMW parked at Wildmoor Spa, early evening of 13th April had its windows smashed and a laptop taken.
- ❖ Vehicle number plates again seem to be vulnerable. A set was taken from Crompton Avenue, Bidford overnight of 21st April. Inc 97/220410.
- ❖ £2500 of cheese was taken from a lorry parked in the lay-by on the A46 at Temple Grafton overnight of 22nd April. The cheese was un-matured and not fit for consumption. Inc 140/230410.



THEFT.

- ❖ A grey/black "Revenge" Kayak was stolen from Bidford Youth Club, Salford Rd on Tuesday 27th April. Inc 49/280410.
- ❖ A quite distinctive Cannondale mountain bike, blue and black in colour was taken overnight of the 25th & 26th April 2010 from Moorfield Road, Alcester. Inc 52/260410.



CRIMINAL DAMAGE.

- ❖ There have been a number of incidents recently on the Big Meadow in Bidford including graffiti being sprayed on the toilet block and a number of skips as well as fencing panels being pulled down on the new play area.
- ❖ Inc 55/260410 relates to 4 unknown youths who were seen to kick a vehicle whilst parked outside an address on Old School Mead, Bidford.
- ❖ Two separate incidents on Beacon Close, Alcester where windows at the property were broken. Inc 251/120410 and Inc 27/130410 relate to the double glazed windows in both the kitchen windows and living room windows being smashed.

What is SMART WATER?

SMART WATER is a unique solution containing a blend of harmless chemicals providing it with a "forensic fingerprint". This fingerprint has been likened in concept to "DNA profiling".

Once applied, SMART WATER makes the possession of stolen property a risky business. When subjected to ultra violet light, its presence is immediately obvious by a telltale fluorescent glow. The smallest amount is enough for forensic scientists to verify the registered owner.

Through Warwickshire Police the cost of each SMART WATER bottle is £15.00, which provides enough coverage for approximately 100 - 150 items dependant on how generous you are, however SMART WATER can be detected as small as a pin head, so very little is required for each item.

Accompanying the solution are SMART WATER stickers for your home, also available are plastic signs for sheds and outhouses. Since SMART WATER is invisible to the naked eye these are designed to advertise the fact that you are SMART WATER protected, so should be placed in a prominent position in order to deter would be thieves.

WE NEED YOUR HELP NEEDED...

A motorcyclist was injured when his vehicle was involved in a collision with a camper van on the A46 between Bidford and Alcester on Sunday morning, April 11. Incident 113 of the 11th April 2010.

The Collision occurred at about 10.20hrs.

The motorcyclist was one of three travelling together towards Alcester and is believed to have been overtaking when the motorcycle was in collision with the rear of the camper van.

The rider, a 45 year old male from the Birmingham area, was thrown from his bike. He was air lifted to Selly Oak Hospital with severe bruising to his body and a suspected chest injury.

He was detained in the intensive care unit.

The female driver of the camper van was taken to the Alexandra Hospital, Redditch with a suspected lower back injury and whiplash. The female passenger, who is pregnant, was also checked over as a precaution but was not injured. A young child in the vehicle suffered minor cuts but was otherwise uninjured.

PC Liam Ryan would like to hear from anyone with information about the incident, particularly anyone who witnessed it or saw any of the vehicles before the collision occurred.

ALCESTER SOUTH SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD PRIORITIES

Current priorities as chosen by members of the public at the last Community Forum held 09/02/10 at Temple Grafton Village Hall:

Anti Social Behaviour around Alcester, especially the Hopkins Precinct. *ASB in the vicinity of Hopkins Precinct, Alcester. 20 directed patrols to be carried out to enforce dispersal area introduced in this area on 1st February 2010, which will run until 1st August 2010. Consultation is to take place between residents, shop owners, landlords and partner agencies to develop action plan. Work is continuing in this area to provide youth and family facilities. 24 Patrols as of 30th April.*

Vehicle Crime in Bidford on Avon and Welford. *Autocrime. 12 x 2 hour patrols in relation to a recent increase in vehicle crime in Bidford on Avon and Welford wards. Implement crime prevention messages through newsletter circulation. 11 Patrols as of 30th April.*

Anti Social Behaviour around Bidford on Avon. *ASB within Bidford on Avon at weekend evenings in vicinity of Wards Lane, Marleigh Park, High Street and allotments near to Crawford Hall. Damage has been caused to fencing and allotment poly tunnels. 15 directed patrols to these areas, full use to be made of Stratford district Council ASB officer in terms of referrals. 24 Patrols as of 30th April.*

GOOD NEWS



- A 36 year old man from Northampton has appeared before magistrates at Nuneaton 12th April 2010 charged with

 - the sexual assault of a child under 13 in Northamptonshire or elsewhere between October 1 2009 and April 7 2010

Daniel John LISHMAN, from Thorpe Street, Raunds, Northamptonshire, was remanded to police cells to reappear before magistrates. Date TBC

- The fence in Marleigh Park, Bidford has finally been painted as well as hawthorn and pyracantha bushes planted in front to prevent further graffiti. Many thanks to the Probation Service for their hard work.
- An Alcester man was stopped on Arden Road Industrial Estate in Alcester and found in possession of cannabis. He was issued with a street caution and the cannabis seized.
- An Alcester youth, who was arrested for damage to a JCB digger, pleaded guilty, was fined £80, order to pay £78 damages and is subject to a 3-month referral order.
- A male and female from Alcester have been charged with possession of class B drugs with intent to supply after the Alcester South SNT executed a warrant.
- A local school pupil has been arrested on suspicion of supplying drugs to pupils in the school.
- A male and female were arrested on 26.4.10 following a theft from Marks and Spencers in Stratford upon Avon. The male was subsequently interviewed and charged with shoplifting offences



from around Warwickshire and Gloucestershire and also with theft of perfumes amounting to over £200 from Lloyd's pharmacy in Alcester.
