## CRIME IN YOUR AREA

This section looks at the crimes of public interest that have occurred on the Alcester South Safer Neighbourhood Team policing beat, crimes such as burglary, theft, auto crime and criminal damage:



### **BURGLARY.**

- Burglaries up on last month, although there were no significant incidents to report on. PLEASE ENSURE YOU CONTINUE TO LOCK THOSE GARDEN SHEDS AND OUTHOUSES.



### **AUTOCRIME.**

- Vehicle crimes down again very slightly this month, especially theft from motor vehicles. Thankfully people are heeding the warning but lets not get complacent and remember PLEASE ENSURE YOU REMOVE ALL ITEMS WHEN LEAVING YOUR VEHICLE.
- 3 vehicles were stolen from Waterloo Rd Industrial Estate in Bidford between 21:00hrs and 23:00hrs on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July. A white Iveco breakdown truck can be seen towing a green Montego away before returning to remove other vehicles. One unit was also broken into as part of these incidents and a number of drills and generators were taken. Incidents 52, 81 & 108 of the 26<sup>th</sup> July 2010.



## THEFT.

- A number of manhole covers and drainage gullies were stolen from along Waterloo Rd, Bidford on Avon up to Wixford around the 22<sup>nd</sup> July. Inc 226/220710. This is a national problem relating to the rise in the value of scrap metal, but not only puts road users at risk, but cost the local Council to repair which reflects in Council Tax increases.
- Overnight of Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July, a number of garden sheds at the allotments by Crawford Hall were broken into and a number of garden tools taken. Incidents 189 & 173 of the 18<sup>th</sup> July relate.



## CRIMINAL DAMAGE.

- The traffic lights on the Honeybourne Road at Bidford Bridge have been vandalised over the past few weeks causing a lot of money to repair as well as putting motorists and pedestrians in jeopardy crossing the bridge.
- On the whole, Criminal damage down slightly on previous months.

## INFORMATION & ADVICE

**With the summer holidays in full swing it's worth keeping an eye on what your kids when they are online. Here are a few simple points.**

- Know what your children are doing online and whom they are talking to at all times.
- Ask them to teach you to use any applications you have never used.
- Keeping the computer in a family room means you can share your child's online experience and that they are less likely to act inappropriately (i.e. via webcam).
- Help your children to understand that they should never give out personal details to online friends - personal information includes their messenger ID, email address, mobile number and any pictures of themselves, their family or friends.
- If your child publishes a picture or video online, anyone can change it or share it. Remind them that anyone may be looking at their images and one day a future employer could!
- If your child receives spam/junk email & texts, remind them never to believe them, and never reply to them or use them.
- It's not a good idea for your child to open files that are from people they don't know. They won't know what they contain - it could be a virus, or worse - an inappropriate image or film.
- Help your child to understand that some people lie online and therefore it's better to keep online mates online. **They should never meet up with any strangers without an adult they trust.**
- Always keep communication open for a child to know that it's never too late to tell someone if something makes him or her feel uncomfortable.
- Teach young people how to block someone online and how to report them if they feel uncomfortable

## ALCESTER SOUTH SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD PRIORITIES

The top three issues raised at the Community Forum held at St Benedict's School, Alcester on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2010 were...

1. **Alcohol related youth issues in Alcester.** Targeted patrols to tackle anti social drinking particularly amongst young persons, to include seizure and enforcement of the dispersal order. Guaranteed 20 extra patrols. 11/20 done so far.
2. **Alcohol related youth issues in Bidford.** Targeted patrols to tackle anti social drinking focussing particularly on young persons, to include seizure where necessary. Guaranteed extra 20 patrols. 8/20 done so far.
3. **Vehicle crime in Alcester and the surrounding villages.** We will have targeted patrols across the whole of the Alcester South patch to counter thefts from Motor Vehicles paying particular attention to car parks. Guaranteed 12 extra patrols. 7/12 done so far.

## GOOD NEWS

- A local youth is on Police bail after being charged with 4 public order offences, criminal damage and possession of drugs.
- 2 people were arrested Wed 28<sup>th</sup> July on possession of class A drugs on Waterloo Rd. Having stopped a vehicle acting suspiciously whilst on patrol, officers searched the car and found a quantity of white powder and some cash as a result a 30 year old male and a 36 year old women were arrested.
- PC Tony Hall has arrested a cross boarder shoplifter on suspicion of three counts of high value thefts from the Waitrose store in Alcester. She is currently on bail with conditions not to enter Warwickshire.
- PCSO's have been out with local Fire Officers, speaking to local youths and educating them on the seriousness of starting small fires in and around the towns and villages.
- Officers have leafleted houses around Bidford and put up posters around town making people aware of vehicle crime as apart of a crime reduction program.
