CRIME IN OUR AREA

BURGLARY

- We received 6 reports of dwellings being burgled in May. 2 in Alcester. 1 in Bidford. 1 in Dunnington. 1 in Welford and 1 in Luddington.
- The 14 offences of Burglary Other related to thefts from sheds, garages and caravans. 5 in Alcester, 6 in Bidford, 1 in Wilmcote, 1 in Welford and 1 in Dunnington.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- We had 8 reported crimes of criminal damage on our area during May. 5 in Alcester, 2 in Bidford and 1 in Aston Cantlow. The majority of these crimes relate to random acts of damage caused by people moving through or gathering in certain areas.
- The Damage in Aston Cantlow relates to an incident where an 'off roader' in a 4X4 has driven through a fence on private land.

THEFTS FROM MOTOR VEHICLES

- 5 in Alcester. 2 at The Oversley Woods car park, 1 in Kings Coughton, 1 in Barton and 1 in Bidford. The majority relate to items left in plain view.

THEFT

- Many of the offences that get classified as Theft relate to items being stolen from gardens, sheds, garages and other out buildings - Similar to 'Burglary Other'.
- A few of the incidents reported to us relate to items being taken from front gardens or from the side of houses by the many 'Scrap dealers' that tour the area on a daily basis. It has become the norm for people to leave out scrap on the front of their premises, so if you do not want an item collecting we suggest it is secured away or a notice stuck to it saying 'Not for Scrap Collection'. We are still compiling a list of vehicles being used by the scrap dealers on our area, so if you can safely record the details and times of when you see a collector, please send them through to us.
- The breakdown of Theft is:- Alcester X 9, Bidford X 7, Broom X 1, Kings Coughton X 1, Wixford X 1, Great Alne X 1 and Kinwarton X 1.

ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (PERSONS AND VEHICLES)

- 1 of the incidents of ASB in Alcester related to a vehicle being used by a driver who had no licence and no insurance. This person was tracked down by the team and 2 vehicles were seized.
- Other incidents of ASB reported to us, were: - 9 in Alcester, 14 in Bidford and 1 in Milcote.

VIOLENCE

- During May we had 10 incidents of 'Violence' reported to us. As always the majority of these offences relate to domestic and neighbour disputes, or when the offender is known by the informant. As a result the information that can be released is limited.
- 1 of the incidents relate to a female being assaulted while she walked along the old railway line, behind Meadow Road in Alcester. More details of this offence will be released at a future date, but we can confirm that the offender was quickly identified and arrested.

What else has been happening....? - Members from the Alcester South SNT and other officers from around the county deal with a number of other incidents on our area. The following list shows the type of incidents recorded during May 2013:- Domestic, Suspicious Incidents, Missing Persons, Arson, Animal issues, Road Traffic Collisions, Alarms, Observations, Concern issues, Malicious Communications, Silent 999 calls, Drugs, Insecure Premises, Neighbour Disputes, Sudden Deaths, Illness / Injuries, Sexual Offences, Road related issues, Fraud, Abandoned Vehicles, Lost / Found Property, Drunkenness and Vehicle Breakdowns.

GOOD NEWS AND WORK BY THE SNT

1. 13/05/13 Arrest of a 47 year old Alcester male for public order offences and criminal damage. Dealt with by way of restorative justice.
2. 16/05/13 Arrest by Alcester South SNT of 2 youths in School Road, Alcester for affray. Both bailed pending further enquiries, one further arrested for possession of cannabis.
3. 17/05/13 Alcester South SNT assisted in a drugs warrant at a Stratford address. Cannabis found and an £80 FPN issued to offender.
4. 22/05/13 3 arrested as a result of an aggravated TWOC of a vehicle from Broom. Vehicle stopped in Bidford by Police. Offenders cautioned.
5. 27/05/13 Male arrested in Alcester following windows being broken at a property in Alcester. Male further arrested for breach of bail conditions.
6. Two vehicles seized in Alcester for no insurance.
7. 05/05/13 Male arrested for drink driving following an RTC at Drayton. Charged to court.
