CRIME IN OUR AREA

BURGLARY

- The Burglary of dwellings has very slightly increased to 3 in June. As in most of the cases of houses being broken into, criminals target the rear of the property. 1 in Great Alne, 1 in Billesley and 1 in Aston Cantlow.
- We have had 7 other buildings broken into during June. Alcester \times 3, Clifford Chambers \times 1, Dodwell \times 1, Grafton \times 1 and 1 on the Stratford Canal.
- During the burglary of the property in Grafton the offenders were disturbed by the occupants and because of the detailed information passed to police the car was tracked and stopped by police as it tried to travel back towards Birmingham.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

• Criminal Damage is down considerably for June. Last months figures were affected by the run of damages to vehicles in the Evesham Street area of Alcester. The breakdown of offences are:- Haselor \times 1, Welford \times 2, Bidford \times 2 and Alcester \times 2.

THEFTS FROM MOTOR VEHICLES

• We had 6 cases of thefts from Motor Vehicles during June. Kinwarton \times 2, Great \times 1, Bidford \times 1, Wilcote \times 1 and Welford \times 1.

THEFT

- We had 14 offences of theft reported to us in June. These offences include everything that is not connected to buildings and vehicles.
- Alcester \times 6, Dodwell \times 1, Bidford \times 2, Ardens Grafton \times 2 and Clifford Chambers \times 2.
- Unfortunately we still have criminals passing through the area stealing oil from domestic tanks.

ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (PERSONS AND VEHICLES)

- We had 5 recorded instances of Anti Social Behaviour in June. This is quite a reduction from May. Alcester x 2, Wilmote x 1, Salford Priors x 1 and Great Alne x 1.
- This type of behaviour can range from a number of issues and does not necessary relate to people on the street.

VIOLENCE

We had 3 reports of Violence in June. 2 in Alcester and 1 in Bidford. At the time of writing this newsletter these reports do not relate directly to the World Cup matches.

SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

- During June we received 23 calls reporting suspicious circumstances.
- If you spot anything that you consider suspicious or out of the ordinary for your road / area then we suggest you call us straight away on telephone number 101.
- The quicker the information gets to us the better our opportunity is to either stop and speak to those involved or to carry out the necessary intelligence checks.

Priority Results From June.

New Priorities have now been set for the Alcester South SNT. These are the results of the last set of priorities that ended in June.

- ♦ Speed Checks in Luddington. 11 extra speed checks were carried out by the Team in Luddington. As a result 9 vehicles were caught exceeding the 30mph limit. The SNT issued the relevant warnings and cautions as required.
- ♦ Illegal Parking by Schools 21 extra patrols were carried out by the team around school premises to target illegal parking etc. As a result a number of drivers were spoken to and warned for committing offences.
- ♦ Speed checks on Throckmorton Road, Alcester. The Team carried out 23 speed checks on Throckmorton Road. 13 of these checks were carried out at specific times acting on information received from residents. Only 1 vehicle was caught exceeding the 30mph limit and was dealt with accordingly with a fine.
