On the 19<sup>th</sup> June an incident occurred in Bretforton Church between 08:00 and 17:15hrs where a cash box was accessed. If anyone has any information please quote 217N 190612.

Between 18:30 on 21<sup>st</sup> and 13:30 on 23<sup>rd</sup> June three catalytic converters have been removed from vehicles in a compound in Bretforton. If anyone has any information please quote 183N 230612.

We are once again receiving reports of callers who are requesting personal information over the phone. The latest incident involved a company by the name of ITC Development Corporation who rang an elderly lady offering a gadget to place on her electricity meter which would reduce the cost of her electric. The caller stated they had the first 4 numbers of the lady's card and requested the other 12. Once again can we remind you not to disclose any personal information over the phone, especially dates of birth and bank account details. If in doubt refuse the call.
