

Marlcliff Flood Alleviation Scheme Update - February 2014

Update for Marlcliff remediation scheme

We would like to update you on the progress of the Marlcliff remediation scheme since the last bulletin we sent you in November 2013.

As previously mentioned we have carried out a post–completion inspection of the Marlcliff flood alleviation scheme and found that it requires some remedial improvements.

The works will involve the extension of the existing flood wall to tie into the high ground near Temple Farm. We will improve access to the scheme by constructing a hard standing area for the village pump and steps to facilitate easier access to the ditch side of the defence. A cabinet will also be installed near to the hard standing area to house the village pump.

After a competitive tender process, for the remediation works, the successful contractor is J N Bentley Ltd. The works are expected to commence in early March and should last about four weeks, weather permitting. The works should cause minimal disruption to the village and the surrounding area.
