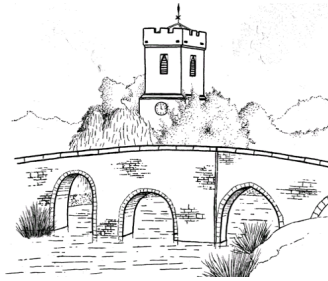


# **BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL**

Installation of 4no new windows. 3no air conditioning condensers and various external alterations

  - ii. **20/01798/FUL Littleton Pastures Solar, Land South of Blakes Hill, Access off Buckle Street, Honeybourne**  
Installation of a solar farm comprising ground mounted solar PV panels with an installed capacity of 31MW, including mounting system, battery storage units, inverters, underground cabling, grid connection hub, stock poof fence, CCTV, internal tracks and associated infrastructure, landscaping and environmental enhancements for a temporary period of 40 years.
